Art.4 – Schedule – Candidate Roll Call

All the candidates must be present for the Roll Call at the Secretariat of the Competition in the Swabian-Norman Castle of Sannicandro di Bari, on 22th July 2007 at 5 p.m.

The candidates will be called in alphabetical order, starting from the letter drawn immediately after the roll call.

Art.5 – Jury and Evaluation

The Jury will be composed of four well-known horn players and one Apulian commissioner.

The four musicians are:

M° Konstantin Becker (Venice, Italy) artistic director;

M° Otto Schmitz (Munich, Germany);

M° Hermann Baumann (Essen, Germany);

M° Simone Baroncini (Napels, Italy).

The Italian Ministerial Law n.2 (11th August 1989) about the Jury incompatibility will be applied. "Yes" or "No" will judge the 1st and 2nd stages.

The names of the candidates admitted to the next stages of preliminary round will be notified by posting.

During the Final stage, the judgement of the Jury will be secret and expressed in hundredths with arithmetic mean, and with the exclusion of the lowest and highest points. The President may round the results up or down.

The First Prize will be awarded to the candidate who will get the highest points.

The judgment of the Jury is unappeable. The Jury could listen only to a time of the sonata.

The Jury reserves the right not to award the prizes.

The organizing committee will place a collaborator pianist at the candidates' disposal. He will be available from 22th July 2007.

Every candidate can choose, at his expense, a pianist to play with.

The Final Stage, in the form of Concert, will be open to the public and to authorities.

During the Final Concert the winners will perform free. Otherwise their prizes will be revoked.
